


BIG BANG SCIENCE FAIR

Prof. John Donoghue from the Brown Institute of Brain Science will talk about "Merging man and machine to help people with paralysis". Find out about the science of Game of Thrones. The evening will conclude with a jazz performance by "God Particle".



Participate in interactive workshops in the lab tent on Market Square (4-10pm), where you can design your own computer program and build a cloud chamber to see the cosmic rain or go to the RISD Graphic Design Center Room 212 to learn how to play the Theremin musical instrument without touching it. Free tickets are required.



Walk up to more creative hands-on activities in Market Square and on College Street (5-10pm)! Stargaze with local astronomers, blend science with art with RIMOSA, explore the wonders of the brain, see cool chemistry experiments and spectacular physics demos, experience virtual reality and computer science in action, learn about medicine and science, the science of cooking, snap a selfie in the tunnel of the Large Hadron Collider at CERN, or solve an intriguing maze – there is so much to do!
